Facilities



SMARTCLASS

Interactivity is a great feature that enhances the interest level of the students in their class leading to more number of hands raised to give answer. The School with Next Education India has installed TeachNext in 28 Classroom and converted it into Smart Class. TeachNext contains a comprehensive curriculum of guided learning sequences that include applet activities, multimedia presentations, practice exercises, and games.



The school has a large well equipped library of 1440sq.ft. area which include books, periodicals, dailies, magazines and computers growing with every passing year along with the school. The school has a well stocked library with around 27000 plus books, 20 plus magazines, periodicals and dailies. The library also provides students and teachers with a range of reference books, encyclopaedia and an E-Library with internet facilities to enrich their classroom activities and knowledge.

LABORATORIES

Children are able to retain the knowledge for longer when they experience and feel the experiments, research, and teaching in front of their eyes. When they observe various things and carry out different experiments and research, their reasoning skills are honed and they start thinking deeply on those theories and concepts. Our school combines classroom teaching with laboratory experiments to ensure that the students grasp each and every concept thoroughly.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LAB

Language is a medium of communication. Students from various cultures feel hard to learn English and its proficiency. The language lab is the solution and need of the hour to learn the English language. Our Language lab has the capability to cater 45 students simultaneously. The study room is equipped with electronic sound-reproduction devices, enabling students to hear model pronunciations of foreign languages.



PHYSICS LAB

The school has a well furnished Physics Laboratory and is equipped with variety of apparatus used to conduct all kinds of experiments.

CHEMISTRY LAB:



Science is a practical subject, teaching of which cannot be done only in theory form. Especially chemistry requires a well equipped and systematically arranged laboratory. Our school has a lavish chemistry lab with various scientific instruments and chemicals.

BIOLOGY LAB:

Biology is the study of life and its evolution, of organisms and their structures, functions, processes, and interactions with each other and with their environments. The school has a well-resourced, ventilated and spacious Biology Lab where the students work individually or in small groups on a question, problem or hypothesis.



MATHS LAB:



Mathematics Laboratory is a place where students can learn and explore mathematical concepts and verify mathematical facts and theorems through a variety of hands-on activities using different materials. We have state-of-art mathematics laboratory which offers Multiple Teaching and Learning Aids as well as a complete theme based ambience to help visualize and feel mathematics.

COMPUTER LAB:

The School has separate computer laboratories for kids and older children, with one-on-one access, which means there is one computer for each child. The school's computer lab has a dedicated broadband Internet connection for students to make them familiar with the Modern Digital Age. It has qualified and committed teachers to teach different classes at different levels i.e. Primary, Middle and Senior Secondary.



SOCIAL SCIENCE LAB:



In Kamla Nehru Hr. Sc. School, we have a spacious laboratory to make students understand social fabric and custom. Group of subjects concerned with Social Science are taught through models, charts and various modern techniques.

Transportation

The school runs buses and magic covering the entire city of Bhopal, and as per the norms laid down by the RTO department. School bus also has Female Attendant to ensure safety and comfort of girl students. The school also has installed tracking system (GPS system) in the buses to help parents to know the exact location of the bus at any given time. The buses are also fitted with high resolution wide angle cameras for surveillance. At the moment, the school runs two separate routes for Kindergarten students and Senior students.



Surveillance

The school premises (inside and outside) is under continuous surveillance. High definition CCTV cameras cover and monitor every part of the school premises- classrooms, laboratories, activity rooms, office, corridors, staircases, ground and area near the washrooms etc. This helps in classroom management and maintaining discipline effectively, helps in identifying intruders or offenders, helps in investigations, etc.

School Activities

EDUCATIONAL TRIP

We believe that students should be exposed to a variety of activities and field trips as it is an essential tool for hands-on learning. Educational school trips that form a part of the school curriculum are very valuable as they provide the students the opportunity of learning through travel, especially to places that they may not otherwise get to visit. School field trip is an effective educational activity for students that helps facilitate fast and efficient learning method. The school organises visits to a variety of cultural institutions, including art, natural



to a variety of cultural institutions, including art, natural history, and science museums, as well as theatres, zoos, and historical sites.



YOGA

Yoga at an early age encourages self-esteem and body awareness with a physical activity that's noncompetitive. In addition, their concentration and sense of calmness and relaxation improves. Keeping in mind the need of inner peace school conducts Yoga classes on regular basis. The practice of the postures (asanas) strengthens the body and creates a feeling of well being. From the psychological view point, Yoga sharpens the intellect and aid in concentrations. In addition to that 3 (three) times meditation (at the start of the day, before lunch and before departure) is also done by all students & teachers.

MARTIAL ARTS (KARATE)

Martial Arts training promote values such as honesty, courtesy, loyalty, and cooperation which provide a supportive environment for learning and personal growth. The self-discipline and self-respect which Martial Arts develop, provides child with the skills and mind-set necessary to resist peer pressure.



SELF DEFENCE (SPECIALLY FOR GIRLS)

The main objective of self defence training is to equip the girl students with useful strategies to defend themselves from spontaneous or pre-mediated violence and abuse. In our school, girl students from classes I to XII are given compulsory training in Self defence.



MUSIC & BAND

The school offers Vocal and Instrumental Music classes for interested students. These classes are taken by well trained and qualified teachers. The Instrumental Music is further divided into Marching Band and Concert Band. School Marching Band practises and performs drills & parades outdoor which consists of students dressed in military styled uniforms. Whereas, the Concert Band practises and performs symphonic and orchestral recitals that are mostly performed indoors. School band is an excellent vehicle for teaching students a host of skills such as discipline, teamwork and the importance of following directions.

SOCIAL SERVICE

We help our students to understand their duties towards society and the nation. We encourage them to undertake services like helping a blind man cross a road, nursing the sick and the old, donate books, food & blood, take active part in the national scheme of afforestation, and help the nation in the removal of illiteracy. Other than this our students take out processions, organize seminars and perform street plays to awaken public opinion against social evils like superstition, blind faith, ignorance to illiterate, drug addiction, casteism, and dowry system.



National Cadet Corp (NCC)

The school has introduced NCC (Army Wing), which offers a wide spectrum of activities. Institutional training is paramount amongst these and it includes conduct of Annual Training Camps. Community Development is another area in which cadets have set an example by involving in various activities viz. adult literacy, anti-drug, anti-leprosy campaigns, planting of trees to conserve ecology etc.


SCOUT & GUIDE

Kamla Nehru Hr. Sec. School strictly follows the Syllabus approved by C.B.S.E. on the pattern and guidelines of N.C.E.R.T. The medium of instruction is English. Sports, Athletic, Social and Cultural programs are regular school activities. Music, Dance, Art & Craft and other socially useful productive works form an integral part of school curriculum. There is special emphasis on Computer Education, Instrumental & Vocal Music, Dance, Drawing, Craft and various sports that are taught by experts. School is going to tie-up with various Sports Authorities such as. T.T. Nagar Stadium and Sports Authority of India (SAI) to provide better opportunities, training and exposure to the students.


Evaluation

The academic year has been divided into 2 terms as per CBSE. It is compulsory to get minimum 'D' grade in oral and written examinations separately. It is compulsory to appear and pass (minimum 'D' grade) in all examinations and tests. Project work is compulsory for all subjects. The marks of project work & assignments are added in grand total. Besides Scholar badges are awarded to the Best student from each class monthly, on the basis of which the declaration of best student for the session is done. Similarly best teachers too are judged and appreciated.

Admission Procedure (FOR BOTH UNITS)


Admissions are purely based on merit. Admissions are to sought through duly filled up registration cum admission form. which is to be submitted in the School Office on or before the specified date. As per Government Rules students above 5 years of age only will be admitted to Class 1st. For Higher Classes add one year for each class. No candidates will be admitted without a Transfer Certificate from the last school attended, countersigned by a appropriate authority and in no case shall a student be permitted to attend classes pending formal admission. If a students

comes from an unrecognized school he/she can be given provisional admission after Eligibility test subject to approval by the Education Department. The Transfer Certificate of a student coming from a school outside M.P. state must be countersigned by the educational authorities of the District in which the School is situated. In case of late admission of a student, the fee from the beginning of the First Term shall be charged unless otherwise ordered by the Principal.

Kindergarten Programme

Kindergarten or Preprimary stage is the foundation of child's knowledge, skills and behaviour. The Kindergarten Programme inculcates in children the qualities of curiosity, exploration and discovery in a fun-filled, happy and safe learning environment. An individualised approach helps nurture a love of learning; develop social skills, and instil moral values. The emphasis is on developing in students, self confidence and the ability to communicate effectively in English.

Primary Education

Primary or Elementary Education starts right after Kindergarten, where students in classes I to V are introduced to academics and the world of learning beyond the classroom. The wide range of curricular and cocurricular opportunities offered helps instil in children confidence and discipline. The focus on developing communication skills helps them appreciate the value of education. The subjects taught at the primary level include English, Hindi, Mathematics & EVS.

Middle Education

The middle school is a smooth transition from Primary to High School. The middle school programme is structured to meet children's varied intellectual and developmental needs. The main aim of the programme is to develop skills related to writing, reading, reflecting, critical thinking, public speaking, fostering initiative among students and a desire to acquire knowledge. Field trips and excursions aid in developing social skills and in raising awareness about the world. The Language Lab and the Mathematics Lab help in an innovative manner to sustain the interest and to develop the language and the mental ability of the child.




Secondary Education
